Dear families

We thank everyone who has contributed to our annual cake stall at the St. Joseph's Fair over the years. The cake stall is always a huge success, we have many people licking their lips and eying off all the goodies, and that is due to all your hard work.

Every year each family is asked to send along one item for the cake stall. We understand that this is not always possible as people are busy, but we would love it if you could. We send home a box for your baking to come back to school in, with a bag and tie. Also in this package is a form to be filled out and attached to your cake stall item. This has a family number on it and a place for you to tell us what your item is and the ingredients in it. *This package will come home in the week of the fair.* It is vital that all ingredients are listed on the sheet. We cannot sell anything that doesn't state all of the ingredients.

If you love to bake, and have plenty of time, you are more than welcome to bring along as many items as you like. *More forms and cake boxes are available at the front office.* Each item must have your family number, name of item and ingredients attached. This is important as we have many members of our community with food allergies/intolerances.

Cakes, slices, biscuits, loafs, sponges, you make it, we'll sell it. We do have lots of people who are gluten free, nut free, etc, so baking for these needs would be greatly appreciated.

We do not have any refrigeration for our cake stall, so please do not send along items that require this. Sponges can be sent along without cream, but jelly slice and similar items require refrigeration and we can't keep them cold. Sorry!

Items for the cake stall can be dropped at the school office on the Friday at the earliest. We would prefer cake boxes to be dropped off at the school hall on the Saturday or even Sunday morning as you arrive at the fair.

We look forward to seeing the wide variety of items that will turn up for our cake stall this year, and hope that if you are a non-baker we have helped make this an easier task for you. If you have any queries please contact the office and a co-ordinator will get back to you. **Happy baking!!**
