This feast commemorates three historical events: the discovery of the True Cross in 326, its initial exaltation for public veneration in 335, and the recovery of the Cross from the Persians in 628.

Although we commemorate these three historical events today, the core of our celebration is not the physical wood of the Cross. Our primary focus is the infinite love shown through Christ's selfless sacrifice.
