Emmanuel College Site (Canterbury Road)

After an extended period of discussion and negotiation with several interested parties the Parish Finance Council has carefully considered the next steps for the former Rice Campus of Emmanuel College.

Upon review it has been determined that the most appropriate course of action is to place the property on the open market.

The Parish is hoping the site will be used in meaningful ways to benefit the wider community.

Arrangements are now being made to appoint real estate agents to manage the sale process on behalf of the Parish Finance Council. Further updates will be provided as this process progresses.

Congratulations to Nick Murrell on his appointment as the Principal of St Joseph's for 2026 and beyond. He is a past teacher and leader at St Joseph's and for the past couple of years he has been the Principal of St Pius X school.

We welcome Fr Robert McCulloch, a Columban missioner to our parish this weekend. He will speak about his work in Pakistan where he has been since 1978.

He is chairman of a Catholic hospital which gives low-cost and free healthcare to those in greatest need and which provides free palliative care to people who are terminally ill with cancer.

He has established free higher educational centres to enable young Catholics to overcome poverty and religious discrimination.

This Tuesday and Wednesday the priest of the Diocese gather in Ballarat for their Council of Priest's meeting.
